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A wealth of inspiration: this is how Londonart's latest collection should be interpreted. A collection based on distinct and diverse moods that are nevertheless inextricably linked to imaginary design, always able to combine elements that may be sometimes dissonant and sometimes purely ton-sur-ton.

Imagination runs unbounded between the powerful themes of vegetation and animal prints, with noticeable references to geometries, in which diagonal bands of more sober shades meet a dreamlike nature: moths, hibiscus flowers, parrots.

Let your imagination run wild with circus imagery, tigers, objects and esotericism that blend into the graphic pattern. Elements that speak to the eye of the beholder. More than simple decorations, more than just details: they are key elements that give the walls a new voice. A submerged Eden can be unweaved between curved lines and earthy colours, in the tropical imagery, enchanted gardens and bursts of vegetation.

Lascia correre la fantasia tra immaginari circensi, tigri, oggettistica ed esoterismo che si fondono nella traccia grafica. Elementi che parlano all'occhio di chi osserva. Non semplici decorazioni, non particolari, ma elementi protagonisti che danno alle pareti una nuova voce. Un eden sommerso si ritrova tra linee curve e colori terrestri, tra immaginari tropicali, giardini incantati, esplosioni di vegetazione.

Flash pops, irreverent polka dots on fluorescent tones, spaces filled with regular geometric shapes that are kaleidoscopic, vibrant and three-dimensional thanks to the perfect combination of lights and shadows, which are sometimes finer, full of gentle pastel hues and sometimes more marked, so much so that they almost seem to simulate rigorous drapes.

And then cotton flowers and delicate fruit for a decorative vintage character, with a modern twist conveyed by the contemporary graphic interpretation. Hints of romanticism, fragments of colour and nuances.

Regular and palpable patterns in which the vivid effect recreates the elegant atmospheres of the early 1900s, or fabrics that find a new life in the vibrant patchwork graphics, whose softness and intertwined weave become tactile and tangible.

Even photography leaves its mark in this wallpaper collection by Londonart: the all-over patterns are tangible subjects for the camera, between crowds and starry skies. And then art, with its skilful rich pastel brushstrokes reminiscent of impressionism and of baroque collages.

Opulent depths, cool shading, but also imagination, lush nature and abstraction: a balance of highly decorative patterns gives voice to the wallpaper, which becomes a pure design element, able to transform every space into a unique, personal and innovative complement to any room. To furnish, through a deep and absolutely personal touch of skilful imagination.


Flash pop, pois dissacranti su toni fluo, spazialità colme di forme geometriche regolari, caleidoscopiche, vibranti e tridimensionali, grazie al perfetto match di luci e ombre, ora più fini, ricche di tenere nuance pastello, ora più marcate e presenti, quasi a simulare drappeggi rigorosi.

E ancora fiori di cotone e frutti delicati, per un mood decorativo rétro rivisitato in chiave grafica contemporanea. Tocchi di romanticismo, frammenti di colore e sfumature. Pattern regolari e materici dove l'effetto è più vivido che mai, capace così di ricreare eleganti atmosfere d'antan di inizio '900, o dove il tessuto rinascce in grafiche patchwork vibranti, la cui morbidezza e la cui trama intrecciata diventano tattili e tangibili.

Anche la fotografia lascia la sua impressione in questa collezione wallpaper Londonart: pattern all-over che sono reali soggetti in camera, tra folle e cieli stellati. E poi l'arte, con le sue pennellate sapienti, ricche in tonalità pastello di memoria impressionista, e collage barocchi.

Opulente profondità, fresche ombreggiature; ma anche fantasia, natura verdeggianti e astrazione: un equilibrio di pattern altamente decorativi danno voce al wallpaper, mai come oggi elemento di puro arredo, capace di trasformare ogni spazio in un complemento unico, personale e innovativo. Per arredare, attraverso un tocco profondo e assolutamente personale, di sapiente immaginazione.

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




ARCHITECT



Nato a Cremona nel 1960, si diploma nel 1978 presso l'Istituto Professionale Internazionale per l'Artigianato Lutario e del Legno di Cremona. Frequenta la Facoltà di Architettura del Politecnico di Milano dove segue i corsi di Achille Castiglioni e Marco Zanuso, laureandosi nel 1986. Parallelamente è allievo della scuola privata Politecnico di Design di Milano dove consegue il diploma nel 1984. Nel 1983 inizia a lavorare presso lo Studio De Lucchi divenendone socio nel 1986 fino al 1991, anno in cui decide di aprire il proprio Studio a Milano. Si occupa di design, interior design, art direction e grafica. Dal 1991 è Art Director di Kartell, ruolo che negli anni ha ricoperto per altre aziende come Flos, De Padova, Foscarini, Moroso, Society (Limonta), Emmemobili. Ha progettato spazi commerciali e allestimenti ma anche uffici e residenze, per clienti privati e marchi dell'arredamento e della moda come Cassina, Dolce e Gabbana, Dada – Molteni & C., Barovier & Toso, Piper- Heidsieck, Missoni, Citroen, Hansgrohe, Martini e Rossi , Swarovski, Veuve Cliquot, Hennessy, Marazzi Group, La Rinascente, Piombo, Ermenegildo Zegna, Renault, Haworth, Emilio Pucci, Zara, Habitat. I suoi prodotti sono nelle collezioni di aziende di design come Kartell, Foscarini, Dada – Molteni, Emmemobili, Moroso, UnoPiù, Lema, Poltrona Frau, Fontana Arte, F.lli Boffi, Richard Ginori, Laufen, Citco, Ragno-Marazzi Group, Memphis, Driade, Panasonic, Pelikan. Una mostra dedicata alle lampade disegnate per Kartell è stata allestita nel 2008, presso il teatro Metropol di Milano. Due di queste lampade, Bourgie e Take, sono nella collezione permanente dell'IMA, Indianapolis Museum of Art (USA); altri prodotti sono stati esposti in musei e mostre nel mondo. Nel 2015 sviluppa il nuovo concept per il museo Kartell di Noviglio, aggiornando il progetto d'interni che aveva ideato nel 1999 e che ha vinto il Premio Guggenheim Impresa & Cultura 2000, come miglior museo d'impresa.

Born in Cremona in 1960 Laviani attends the Istituto Professionale Internazionale per l'Artigianato Lutario e del Legno di Cremona, receiving his degree in 1978. He later attends the Faculty of Architecture, at the Politecnico di Milano where he graduates in 1986, while attending at the same time the Scuola Politecnica di Design in Milan from 1982 to 1984. In 1983 he starts working for Michele De Lucchi; he becomes a partner in 1986 and works there until 1991, when he decides to open his own studio in Milan. Laviani's work mainly focuses on product design, interior design, art direction and graphic. Since 1991, he is the Art Director for Kartell; same role he has played for other companies such as Flos, De Padova, Foscarini, Moroso, Society (Limonta), Emmemobili. He has designed retail spaces and set-ups, offices and houses for private clients, as well as for furniture and fashion brands like Cassina, Dolce e Gabbana, Dada – Molteni & C., Barovier & Toso, Piper- Heidsieck, Missoni, Citroen, Hansgrohe, Martini e Rossi , Swarovski, Veuve Cliquot, Hennessy, Marazzi Group, La Rinascente, Piombo, Ermenegildo Zegna, Renault, Haworth, Emilio Pucci, Zara, Habitat. His products are included in the collection of several brands: Kartell, Foscarini, Dada – Molteni, Emmemobili, Moroso, UnoPiù, Lema, Poltrona Frau, Fontana Arte, F.lli Boffi, Richard Ginori, Laufen, Citco, Ragno-Marazzi Group, Memphis, Driade, Panasonic, Pelikan. In 2008 an exhibition was dedicated to the lamps he designed for Kartell, being set up at Teatro Metropol in Milan. Bourgie and Take lamps for Kartell are part of the permanent Collection of IMA, Indianapolis Museum of Art (USA); also other products have been featured in museums and shows all over the world. In 2015, Laviani develops the new concept for Kartell Museum in Noviglio, updating the interior design he had conceived in 1999, when he received the award Premio Guggenheim Impresa & Cultura 2000, as the best museum of a company.

product Atomizers, produced by Seletti, becomes part of the Permanent collection of Italian Design by Triennale Museum of Milan. Her work currently spans from limited editions for design galleries and museums, to special commissions for outstanding brands as: Alpi, Atipico, BottegaNove, Durame, Fendi, Flexform, Fujifilm, Antonio Frattini, Ichendorf Milano, Mogg, Seletti, Tonelli Design e Torremato. She works as a creative director for exclusive brands and as an architect she is engaged in challenging interior and exhibition projects. She works and lives in Milan.

Cristina Celestino è nata a Pordenone nel 1980. Nel 2005 si è laureata presso lo Iuav di Venezia. Con i suoi punti di forza in architettura ha iniziato a lavorare con diversi studi di architettura, prima di spostare l'attenzione su architettura e design d'interni. Nel 2009 si trasferisce a Milano dove ha fondato il suo marchio di design sotto il nome di "Attico", che produce lampade e mobili caratterizzati da una profonda ricerca sui materiali e sulle forme. Nel 2012 è stata selezionata per partecipare al Salone Satellite e dopo questa esperienza i prodotti Attico sono stati esposti in numerose gallerie internazionali e showroom. Il prodotto Atomizers, prodotto da Seletti, fa parte della collezione permanente del design italiano del Triennale Museum di Milano. Il suo lavoro attualmente comprende edizioni limitate per gallerie di design e musei, a commissioni speciali per marche eccezionali. Lavora come direttore creativo e come architetto si impegna in progetti impegnativi e interni. Nel 2016 Cristina viene assegnato con il premio speciale della giuria al Salone del Mobile. Nello stesso anno, in occasione di DesignMiami /, Cristina disegna la collezione "The Happy Room" per FENDI. Lavora e vive a Milano.

Carlo Colombo

ARCHITECT



Carlo Colombo is considered one of the most important international Architect and designer. He started his career right away with designing for top level brands. From this moment he collects hundreds of collaborations with the most important brands of design made in Italy like Antonio Lupi, Artemide, Bentley Home, Bugatti Home, Flou, Flexform, Franke, Giorgetti, iGuzzini, Penta, Poliform, Trussardi Casa, Varenna, just to mention some. Beyond the design of products and furniture, Colombo also takes care of strategy and marketing for the companies, develops graphic projects and curates exhibitions, works as a consultant and Art Director. The work that initially was concentrated on design and interior, extends progressively also in the field of constructions in Italy and abroad. In 2004 the architect is awarded as designer of the year; in 2009 wins an international competition for the design of the two multifunctional towers in Abu Dhabi and from 2011 teaches design at the De Tao Masters Academy of Beijing in China. He receives a lot more awards all over the world, amongst them the Elle Decor International Design Award in 2005, 2008, 2010, 2011, the Good Design Award of the European Centre for Architecture Art Design and the Chicago Athenaeum in 2009, in 2012 and 2014 e 2016 he wins the Red Dot Design Award, the Interior Innovation Award e and the iF design award with Teuco. In 2017 in Switzerland he was awarded by the Italian Console with title of Knight of Order of Merit for Labour. Also in 2017, he won the International Design Award in Los Angeles with the sculpture armchair "784", and he was also included in the volume "100 Italian excellences". Today the studio deals with projects in large scale all over the world, from design to interior as well as architecture.

INTERIOR DESIGNER



In the 1990s, he set up his studio in Florence, working with major art galleries for two decades and emerging onto the contemporary scene of Italian painting. He currently lives and works in Milan where he has a home-studio in which he creates pictorial illustrations for some of the major fashion brands on the international scene.



Elena Salmistraro


PRODUCT DESIGNER



Product designer and artist, Elena Salmistraro lives and works in Milan. Graduated from Polytechnic University of Milan in 2008, she founded her own studio together with architect Angelo Stoli in 2009, where she has been working on architectural and design projects ever since. She works as a product designer and artist/illustrator for various creative industry's leading companies, including Alessi, Bosa, Seletti, De Castelli, B-Line, Bitossi Home, LuisaViaRoma, Yoox, NasonMoretti, Massimo Lunardon, Okinawa, Texturae, Stone Italiana, Effecte, MyHomeCollection, Durame. Besides, she collaborates with prestigious Art and Design Galleries, such as Dilmos, Rossana Orlandi, Camp Design Gallery and Secondome. Her creations are the result of an art – design mix; utmost care for details, painstaking search for shapes' harmony and poetic style characterize her projects. One of her work's priorities is the search for objects' expressive language, which may fascinate people by evoking emotions. Her projects have been selected for some of the most important art exhibitions including: "The New Italian Design", a traveling exhibition organized by the Triennale Design Museum of Milan, curated by Silvana Annicchiarico and Andrea Branzi, with stops in San Francisco, Santiago de Chile, Cape Town; the "The New Aesthetic Design" at 2013 Shanghai Biennale for Triennale Design Museum and at 2015 Gwangju Biennale, South Korea. In 2016, during the XXI edition of the International Exhibition of Triennale of Milan, she took part in W-Women in Italian Design, Triennale Design Museum's ninth edition. In the same year, during the art event "Normali meraviglie La Mano" curated by Alessandro Guerriero and Alessandra Zucchi, she painted a hand designed by the artist Mimmo Paladino, which was exhibited at the Triennale of Milan. In 2017 was appointed Ambassador of Italian Design in the world, on the World Day dedicated to italian design - "Italian Design Day" - an initiative promoted by the Triennale di Milano in collaboration with Ministero degli Affari Esteri and Ministero dei Beni e delle Attività Culturali. On the occasion of the "White in the City" event, promoted by Oikos and curated by Giulio Cappellini, she contributed with Alessi to the project/installation "L'esercito delle spazzole". In 2017 won the "Best Emerging Designer Award" at Salone del Mobile- "Salone del Mobile Milano Award". Elena Salmistraro's works have been displayed at major Italian and international design industry fairs, including Salone Internazionale del Mobile (Cosmit-Milano), Step 09 (Milano), Maison&Objet-Paris, Salone Internazionale del Mobile (Cosmit-Milano), Stockholm furniture and light fair_(Stockholm, Sweden).

ARCHITECT



Architect and designer Maurizio Lai was born in Padua in 1965 and studied Architecture in Venice and Milan. He started his career as set designer for the national TV broadcasters, while working on retail and display concepts for major luxury brands, such as Longines, Montblanc and Gucci, among others. Consisting of a team of architects, engineers and designers the Studio promotes synergies of expression, approaching the design process in a distinguished original way, which determine the production of rather impacting concepts for the retail, commercial and hospitality industry, as well as for private residential projects and developments. An original interpreter of contemporary aesthetics, Maurizio Lai's work is defined by an instinctive approach, which certainly reflects in the originality of his lighting creations. His style has been described as one of the most interesting in the Italian contemporary scene. Along with the creativity, the years-long experience with the high-end design manufacturing process and a strong network of trusted construction partners enables the Studio to deliver detailed, bespoke and beautifully crafted projects worldwide. Maurizio Lai's work has been recognized with prestigious acknowledgments through time, his work is featured in the most authoritative architecture and design publications.

Architetto, scenografo e designer, Maurizio Lai nasce a Padova, studia Architettura a Venezia e al Politecnico di Milano, dove si laurea. DESIGNER



As a child she fondly exercise the use of the words and spends hours making up stories and adventures, perched on a tree branch in her grandmother's garden. At the age of nine, believing she had enough material, she begins to compose a collection of short stories with an old typewriter. Thanks to theater and opera, turning fifteen, she twigs she wants to become a scenographer. At present she is a freelancer scenographer, she designs and manufactures fittings for shop windows, exhibitions, events, interior design, advertising, photo shoots and any space which is hungry of ethereal presences. She draws on walls, on paper and on any possible surface where her black stroke can flow. From February till December 2012 she has been writing for Blogosfera, implementing her knowledge about the web. In January 2015, Logos edizioni decided to publish a monograph on her most significant papercraft works: "PAPER VISIONS", for which Elena also provides the text.

His artistic education began in her family: the father was a painter and a graphic and the mother a decorator; they transmitted her since her childhood the passion about drawing and knowledge of many artistic techniques. Born in Livorno in 1882 from a Jewish family. In 1902 he enrolled in the "Free School of Nude" of Florence and a year later he moved to Venice where he attended the Institute of Fine Arts in Venice. In the 1906 he moved to Paris, the focal point of the Avant-Garde. Jon brings in his work an ancient ideal of Art, but his subjects are subjected to a process of depersonalization. The "real" model loses detail and consistency, stripped of his identity, in favor of a synthetic entity far from the time.


